



## Summary of terms and conditions of the 1st International Interpretation Contest of Contemporary Music "Re\_Cre@"

- The contest is open to interpreters and artists of any nationality who perform recent
  musical works, defined as the so called contemporary music, acoustic music,
  electroacoustic and/or mixed music, sound art and other kind of multidisciplinary and
  multimedia musical creations as long as they need to be performed by musicians. From
  duets to sextets.
- The age limit of the group members **must be 35**.
- It is allowed a free repertoire between **15 and 30 minutes** as long as it was **created in the last 50 years.**
- The prize will be a contract to perform **two concerts in renowned specialised festivals** and the **premiere** of a piece composed by a Valencian composer or resident, **commissioned by the IVC** (Institut Valencià de Cultura). The concerts will take place during the year 2019 in the **41º Festival Ensems** and the **VIII Rafel Festival.** The amount allocated to the concerts will cover a professional price ticket for the artists up to **6.000€ before deductions** (3.000€ from each festival).
- The contest will consist of two stages. A first selection based on the curriculum and a recording and a second stage with a public audition of the selected groups.
- The contest will be part of the programme of the VIII Rafel Festival and the second stage will take place in the Auditori Rafelbunyol in Rafelbunyol (Valencia) on the 12th of October, 2018.
- The panel on the second stage will be formed by soloists of **Ensemble Modern** from Frankfurt and **Ensemble d'Arts.**
- Registration closing date: 7th September, 2018.
